



ENCORE

With the sounds of our best performances still hanging in the air, and the thrill of placements still pulsating through the audience, the Encore Performances will begin – the quartet encores will immediately follow the quartet contest, and the chorus encores will immediately follow the chorus contest. They will be crisp caps of super-charged energy, much like a rich, yummy desert.



Quartet Encore Order of Appearance (Friday night)

Along with these performances, there will be the presentation of regionally created quartet awards.

- 3rd place quartet – two songs
- 2nd place quartet – two songs
- 1st place quartet – two songs

Quartets will enter and exit the stage the same way they did in contest.



Chorus Encore Order of Appearance (Saturday late afternoon)

Along with these performances, there will be the presentation of regionally created awards.

- 3rd place chorus – one song
- 2nd place chorus – one song
- 1st place AA division (small chorus) winner – one song
- 1st place AAA division winner (mid-size chorus) – one song
- 1st place overall winner (Chorus Champions) – two songs

(A chorus winning two of these placements will sing once – in the slot closest to the end of the encore performances.)

Choruses will enter the stage the same way they did for the contest and exit the stage via the steps in front of the stage.

The MC microphone at the podium will be available for a designated chorus member to convey any on-the-spot thank-you's

We hope you'll enjoy this year's format for the encores. These performers will also be giving fuller performances at September's Pep Rally, which – when you think about it – is actually a show of our best quartets and choruses – like a really big encore performance for us.
