



HOUSING INFORMATION

For Chapter at Large members and Chorus members

Reno is the site for Region 12's 2010 Regional Convention "**Wired For Sound**" the weekend of April 22-25, 2010. Members and competitors from Sweet Adelines Region 12 will be housed at the Grand Sierra Resort, located at 2500 East Second Street, Reno, Nevada. Rooms will be ready for check-in at 3 p.m. Check out is at 11 p.m. All parking including valet is free.

ROOM INFO - The price for a single / double room on floors 1 to 16 is \$89 per night plus a \$10 resort fee and 13% tax (\$111.87). If you chose to reserve an upgraded single / double room on floors 17 – 23, the cost would be \$105 per night plus a \$10 resort fee plus 13% tax (\$129.95). The upgraded rooms include refrigerators, coffee makers, and microwaves. Each additional person beyond two people in a room costs an additional \$20. So, for three people in the \$89 dollar rooms, the cost per night would be \$134.47 and for four people, \$157.07. The same rule applies to upgraded rooms and all suites. In the case of an upgraded room, the cost for three people would be \$152.55 and for four people, \$175.15. Two people may reserve a single / double room with two beds. There are a limited number of refrigerators available for the \$89 rooms at the cost of \$5 per day. Medical needs will be given priority. There are no Corner King rooms available but there are small suites available based on availability. Check with your Chorus Housing Chairperson or with Sue Booth, Convention Housing Coordinator or her assistant, Maxine Verma, for more details about these options. All individual reservations need to be sent to Sue Booth, Housing Coordinator on or before **March 1, 2010**.

SPECIAL REQUESTS - We will make every effort to satisfy any special requests, however, please understand that it may not be possible to do so in all cases. Roll-away beds (\$10 per night) are limited in number and may be requested for king-bedded rooms or suites only, due to fire restrictions.

Requests for connecting rooms are not guaranteed and reservations are based on availability. It is suggested that quartet members consider arriving early or reserving a small suite. The connecting room configuration at the Grand Sierra Resort has a King bedroom connecting to a room with two queen beds OR a room with two queen beds connected to a room with two queen beds. If you wish to reserve this type of room you will need to check

into both rooms at the same time and hope they are available.

THURSDAY ARRIVALS RECOMMENDED – Since rooms may not be available prior to 3 pm, a Thursday arrival is recommended. The Quartet Contest will likely start as early as 3:00 p.m. on Friday and there will be activities for the quartets on Friday morning. There are also some very exciting activities planned for the membership on Thursday evening.

PICK A ROOM CAPTAIN - A room captain must be designated for each room. She will be financially responsible for the entire room for the weekend. The room captain will collect individual payments from her roommates so that the hotel will only deal with one person per room. All rooms must be guaranteed by credit card or a check for the cost of one night included with the housing form. The room captain will receive confirmation of the room reservation and should give a copy of the confirmation to each roommate.

CHANGES AND CANCELLATIONS – All changes and cancellations must be done directly with your Chorus Housing Chair, the Regional Housing Coordinator, Sue Booth, or her assistant Maxine Verma. (msverma@yahoo.com) **All individual reservations must be handled by Sue Booth or Maxine Verma.** Individuals should NOT contact the hotel directly for any reservation, changes or cancellations. **DO NOT CALL OR EMAIL THE HOTEL FOR ANY REASON.** We will handle any issues you have.

CHECK-IN - Room check-in is after 3 p.m. When you check in, be sure to know the name of your room captain and have the copy of the confirmation with you as well as photo identification such as your driver's license.
