

Convention Information

ALL-EVENTS TICKETS AND BADGES – Your All-Events Badge is your ticket of admission to the Quartet and Chorus competitions and the Afterglow. You will not be admitted without it (unless you are in performance costume).

REGION 12 SEATING POLICY – To be fair to all attendees, it is the policy of Region 12 that any attendee at an event may *save only one seat adjacent to her or his own*. Blocking of rows or areas of seats is not permitted except as authorized by the Regional Management Team or the Chair of the Regional Convention.

VIP SEATING - Invitations to sit in the VIP section are issued by the Regional Events Coordinator. Please respect this seating area.

HANDICAPPED SEATING – Several areas are set aside to accommodate those in wheelchairs, walkers, etc. Please make sure that these seats are available to those who need them.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES – As a courtesy to our performers and those in the audience, be sure to <u>SILENCE</u> all cell phones, tablets, and alarms while inside the competition room. **NOTE:** If you are following the program on an electronic device, please make sure the device screen is OFF during all performances.

Meet the Chorus Emcee

Suzanne Olsen

Having sung in choral groups all her life, when Suzanne and her husband, Tom, moved to Tokyo, Japan in 1986, she followed through on a recommendation to check out a Sweet Adeline chorus -- and was immediately hooked. In no time, she was in her first quartet, and within two years Suzanne was directing the Tokyo Chorus, which she continued until Tom was transferred to Bangkok, Thailand.

In Bangkok, at the urging of another far-flung Sweet Adeline, she started another chorus. There were 18 women at their first rehearsal, and the Bangkok Chorus was formed -- growing eventually to 35 members from all over the world.



Two years later, Tom was transferred to Mexico City, Mexico. Suzanne quickly found a women's chorus, and after a rehearsal, she taught them a tag and laid out plans to start a SAI chorus, encouraging them to invite more good singers. They did and the Mexico City Chorus was formed. A chorus highlight -- singing back up for Michael Boulton in the National Auditorium! Suzanne also formed a quartet, the Taco-Belles.

After four years, Tom was transferred to the Bay Area, where Suzanne joined her first AMERICAN SAI chorus, Harmony Crossroads. She has also been a member of Pacific Empire Chorus, Pride of the Pacific Chorus, and Mix Up, Canzonet and LiveWire Quartets. She is currently a proud member of Diablo Vista Chorus.

Alison Miller joins us for her first time in the host seat. We are so very happy to have her with us! Well known for being our Region 12 Education Coordinator, Alison is a 14-year member of SAI singing and choreographing for Sacramento Valley Chorus and more recently as a dual member with DVC. She is an elementary school teacher.

Averi Brickson returns, ecstatic to be hosting our webcast again. She is a barbershop brat having grown up singing barbershop in high school and college, and ringing chords with her family. 




Emergency Procedures

Nugget Casino Resort

The Nugget has an Emergency Response Team (ERT) that will respond to all emergencies. This team is trained in First-Aid/CPR and is AED certified. Dial "0" for the operator and they will dispatch Security.

- In an emergency please give the location and type of emergency. If it involves a person, attempt to get the following information:
 - 1. Approximate age including male or female
 - 2. Location or type of injury
 - 3. Medications this person is taking
- Stay on the phone with the operator and convey any additional information while waiting for assistance to arrive. Please do not hang up the phone; the Operator may have additional questions asked by the ERT or emergency services.
- The Nugget has Security on duty 24 hours/day, 7 days/week. Building cameras are recording 24 hours/day, 7 days/week as well. Security patrols the entire hotel including the immediate areas outside of the building. Security can be contacted through the operator "0".
- In the event that an emergency arises, announcements will be made through the hotel's Public Address System. In the event of fire alarm activation, the system has an automatic evacuation announcement that will include a message instructing you on what to do and where to go.
 Depending on the location of the alarm activation, the elevators may or may not be operable.
 Emergency stairs are available at the end of the corridor on both the north and south ends of the building.
- Hotel staff will respond to all emergencies. If you are unsure about what to do or where the
 emergency exits are located, please review the fire evacuation procedures and map on the back
 of the guest room entry door. Be aware that all emergency exits have EXIT signs above the
 door.
- We have safes in all guest rooms and at the Cashier's Cage and encourage you to place all valuables there.
