Beginner Program

- Nine modules based on the SA Arranger Guide and supplemental materials.
- The format of the ACP Beginner Level program closely mirrors the format of the Director Certification (DCP) program, with testing conducted in-Region.
- Beginners will register with HQ, pay a registration fee, conduct self-study and begin taking exams at their own pace.
- Significant different from the DCP
 - Modules must be taken in order, except for Modules 2 and 9
 - A minimum score of 80% is required in order to advance to the next module
 - Module 1 (Music Theory) will have reciprocity with the DCP Music Theory Module 9, if the participant scored at least 80% on the DCP module.
- The ACP Administrator's Guide (Beginner Level) will contain complete program details once completed
