

SAI Arranger Certification Program

Intermediate Education

- Module 10 – the Arranger Cohort Experience (ACE)
- Application will be required.
 - Completion of beginner fundamentals is a pre-requisite
 - A “challenge” is being designed for those wishing to bypass the beginner level
- Co-hort based: small groups of beginning arrangers.
- A practical module with hands-on arranging of a common vehicle.
- Facilitated by Certified or Master Music Arrangers.
- Will leverage video conferencing and email technologies.
- Duration tbd, but learner commitment will be between six months and one year.

Advanced Education

- The format of the ACP Advanced Level program closely mirrors the format of the former IMAP program.
- ACP Scholarship funding will be provided for a period of up to two years. Individual mentoring will be provided by a Certified Music Arranger (CMA) or Master Music Arranger (MMA).
- Candidate will have the opportunity to apply for advancement to Certified Music Arranger (CMA) status upon successful completion.

When will it begin?

Registration will open in the new fiscal year (May 1, 2019) for the Beginner level. Intermediate level is tbd – it will be announced once design is complete and technology is determined.

Advanced Level is in early stages with candidates being evaluated for scholarship award on May 1, 2019.
